This ATV experience combines adventure, culture, and breathtaking natural views. Ride along rural paths, visit the enigmatic circular terraces of Moray, and explore the ancient Maras salt mines.

ITINERARIO

Start your day with energy and get ready for an unforgettable adventure. We will pick you up from your hotel and head toward the community of Cruzpata, where our ATV experience begins. There you will receive a brief safety briefing and a guided practice session to familiarize yourself with the ATV, perfect even if it is your first time, as our team will support you at all times. We will begin the ride along rural paths surrounded by fields, mountains, and spectacular Andean landscapes as we make our way to Moray, the enigmatic Inca complex of circular terraces that functioned as an agricultural laboratory, created by the microclimates generated across its different altitude levels. We will then continue to the Maras Salt Mines, an impressive ensemble of more than three thousand white salt pools where you will learn about their ancestral salt extraction techniques.

We will finish by returning on the ATVs to Cruzpata and then heading back to Cusco with memories filled with adventure, history, and nature.

- Bring your ID and cash for snacks, souvenirs, and other expenses, as not all places accept cards.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Avoid feeding or getting too close to local animals that roam freely.
- Respect all archaeological sites; do not climb on structures or touch ancient elements.
- Support local artisans; Chinchero is famous for its handmade textiles.
- Carry cash, as small towns do not always accept card payments.
- Take care of the environment; do not leave trash and use reusable bottles.
- Follow your guide's instructions to fully enjoy this experience.
