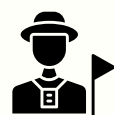

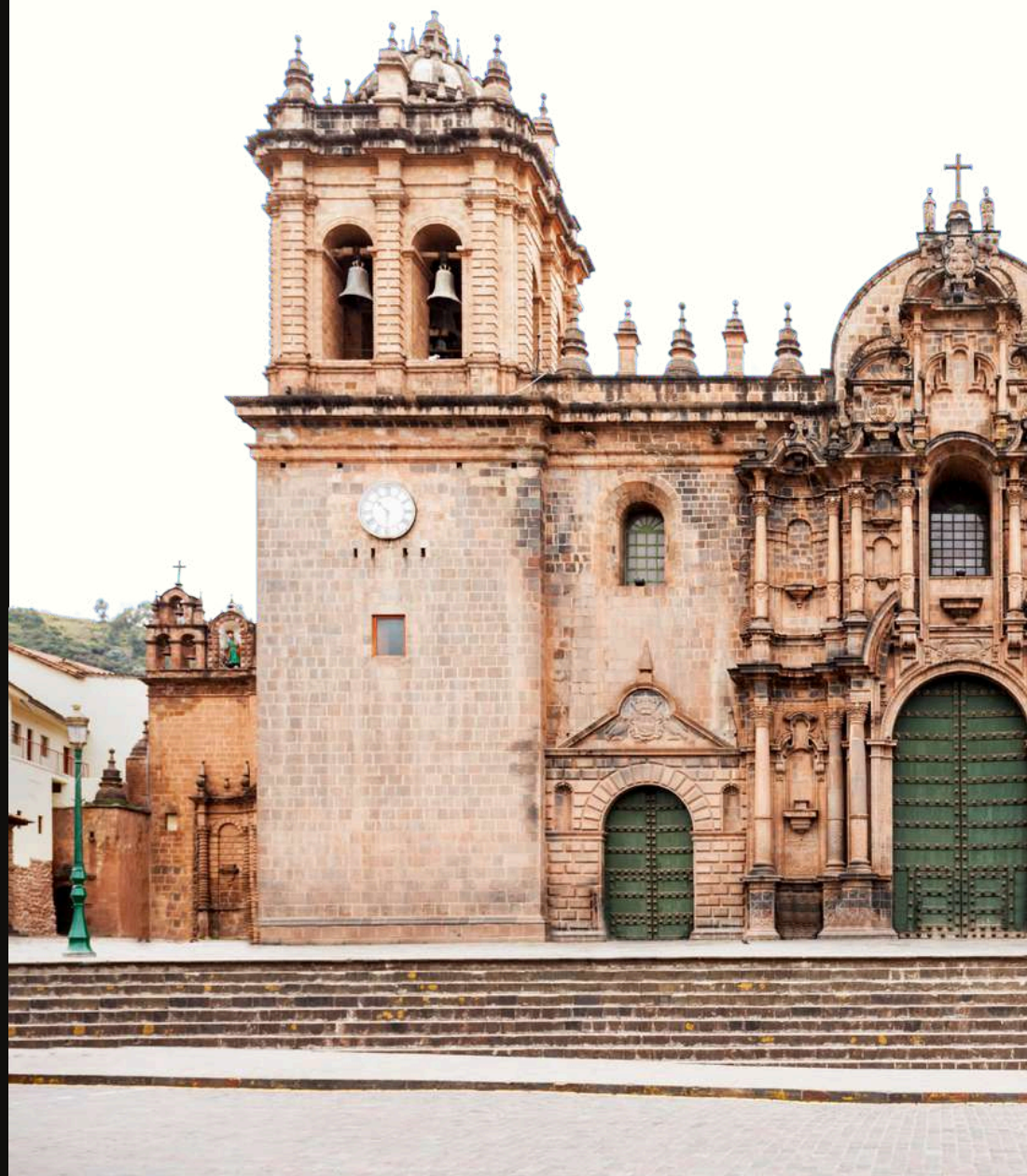
# CUSCO CITY TOUR

Embark on a fascinating journey to the heart of the ancient Inca Empire and be amazed by the richness of Andean civilization, the impressive pre-Hispanic engineering, and the art of the colonial period—all in a unique half-day experience.

## ITINERARY

This experience begins with a visit to the Cusco Cathedral, majestic for its baroque style and indigenous worldview, expressed in its gold-covered altarpieces and the masterpieces of the Cusco School, including its most emblematic image, the Lord of the Earthquakes, the sworn patron of Cusco. We then continue to the Temple of the Sun, Qoricancha, where you will be amazed by the Inca stone walls, perfectly carved and incredibly precise. The site is now embraced by the Dominican convent, a remarkable representation of the fusion of two very different worlds that shaped Cusco's history.

Finally, we head to the hills surrounding the city to explore the monumental archaeological sites nearby. These include Sacsayhuaman, known for its massive stone walls fitted together with astonishing accuracy, Qenqo, a sacred site where rituals were performed on carved rock, and Pukapukara and Tambomachay, ancient ceremonial control points and water temples.

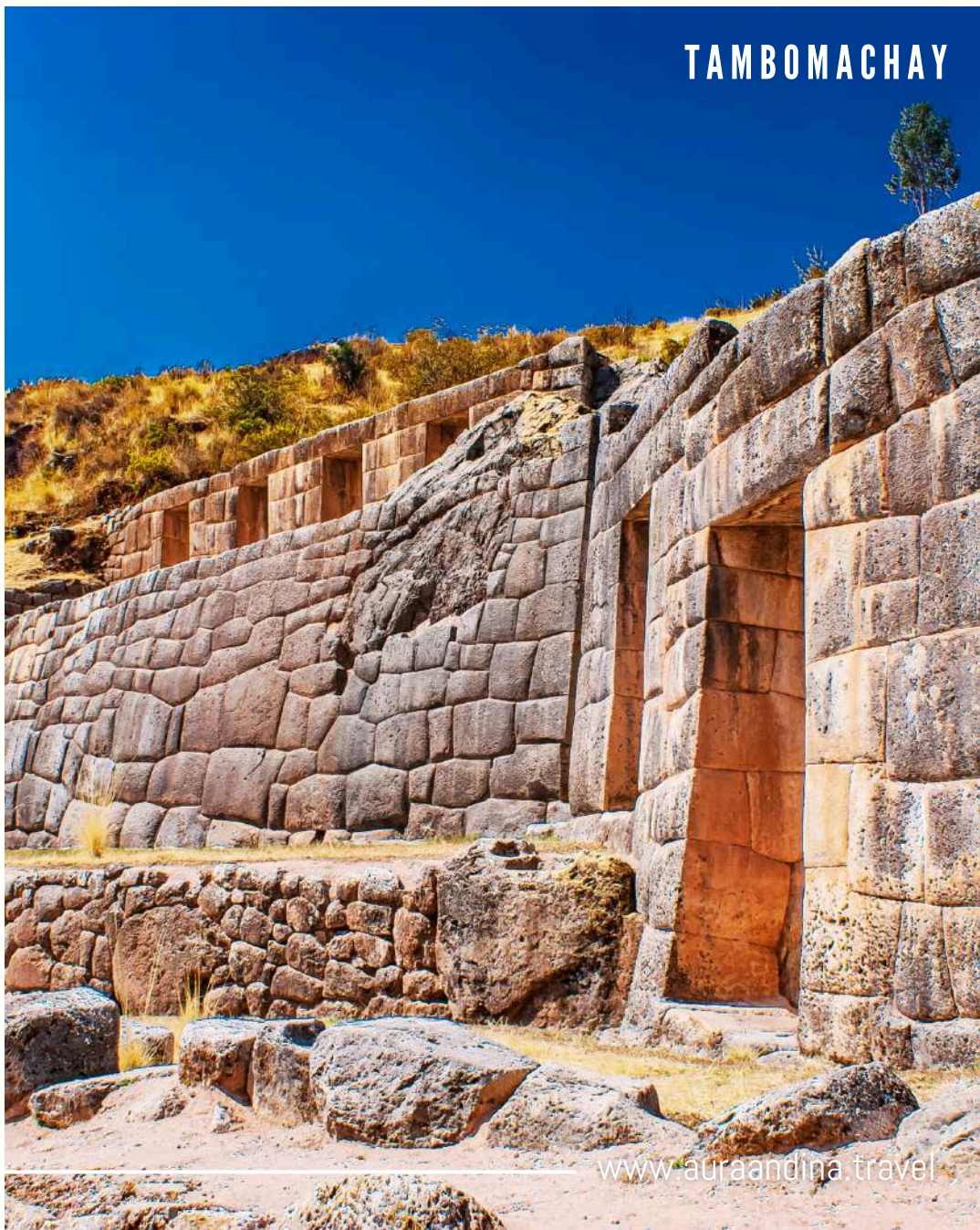

## WHAT TO BRING?

- Dress in comfortable, layered clothing, including a light jacket, as the weather in Cusco can change suddenly.



- 
- Stay hydrated and choose light meals so you can enjoy the tour without discomfort.



- 
- Wear comfortable shoes, as you will be walking through archaeological sites with dirt paths.



- 
- Bring cash for snacks, souvenirs, and other expenses, as not all places accept cards.



- 
- Use sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat, as the sun in Cusco is strong.

## RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Avoid heavy meals before the tour to prevent altitude-related discomfort.
- Coca or muña tea is ideal for reducing symptoms of altitude sickness and is also part of the local culture.
- Respect temples and archaeological sites by keeping your voice low; do not climb the walls or touch the stone structures.
- Keep your camera charged and make the most of every opportunity to capture the attractions.
- Respect the schedule, as archaeological sites have set hours and regulations. Be punctual at each stop to enjoy the entire itinerary.
- Enjoy the pace of this tour, as you will explore several places filled with history through their streets, temples, and landscapes.
