TOUR INTI RAYMI

Every June 24th, Cusco brings to life one of the most important events of its festival season: the Inti Raymi, an ancient Inca ceremony in honor of the Sun God. This celebration features a vibrant spectacle filled with color, music, dances, and profound symbolism.

ITINERARIO

The Inti Raymi experience begins at Qoricancha, where the Inca performs the opening ceremony with prayers and offerings to the Sun God in a solemn atmosphere illuminated by the first light of dawn. From there, the celebration continues in the Plaza de Armas, which transforms into a vibrant stage filled with ancestral dances, Andean music, and colorful costumes that bring energy and tradition to every corner. The most impressive moment takes place at the Saqsayhuamán esplanade, the third and most anticipated stage, where a grand performance of rituals, music, and hundreds of actors brings to life the deep connection between the Andean people and the sun. At the end of the celebration, we will return to your hotel with the feeling of having experienced something truly unique and unforgettable.

WHAT TO BRING?



- Wear comfortable, warm layered clothing, including a hat and gloves, as the weather in this area can change suddenly.



- Wear comfortable and sturdy hiking shoes, as you will be walking on uneven trails.



- Use sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat, as the sun in this area of Cusco is very strong.



- Wear comfortable, warm layered clothing, including a hat and gloves, as the weather in this area can change suddenly.



- Bring your ID and cash for snacks, souvenirs, etc., as not all places accept cards.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Book in advance, as Inti Raymi is the most attended event of the year in Cusco.
- Bring everything you need, as the ceremony at Saqsayhuamán lasts several hours outdoors.
- Be patient with traffic and the large number of visitors.
- Book early, as spots are limited and demand is very high. Ideally, reserve 3 to 6 months in advance.
- Keep in mind that the ceremony takes place across three different stages: Qoricancha, the Plaza de Armas, and Sacsayhuamán, with the latter being the most important.
