
SACRED VALLEY TOUR



Discover the magic of the Sacred Valley of the Incas and let yourself be captivated by an ancient culture that still lives on in every stone, every landscape, and every vibrant tradition of the Inca people.

ITINERARY

We will pick you up from your hotel and head to the charming town of Písac, where we will explore its archaeological site, famous for its terraces and panoramic views, and visit the traditional artisan market, where you can admire and, if you wish, purchase handmade products crafted by local artisans. Next, we will continue to Urubamba, where we will enjoy lunch before traveling to Ollantaytambo, known for its majestic Inca terraces that lead to the impressive Temple of the Sun, a true masterpiece of Quechua engineering. Here you will learn more about the construction techniques of the ancient Incas while enjoying beautiful views of the valleys and ruins. To end the day, we will take an alternate route to Chinchero, a place renowned for its textile art and its colonial church built on Inca foundations in the seventeenth century. After the visit, we will return to Cusco and drop you off at your hotel so you can relax after a day filled with history, culture, unforgettable landscapes.


