

SACRED VALLEY VIP




The Sacred Valley surrounds you with its magic, history, and living culture. This tour unveils its archaeological treasures and most iconic Andean landscapes, offering a more complete experience compared to the traditional version.

ITINERARIO

Our adventure begins right at your hotel in Cusco, where we'll pick you up and take you to Chinchero, a picturesque village where time seems to stand still. There, local families proudly share their traditional dyeing and weaving techniques, transforming wool into true works of art. We continue to Maras, famous for its more than three thousand salt ponds that glisten under the Andean sun, used since Inca times up to the present day. Next, we visit Moray, an astonishing Inca agricultural laboratory whose circular terraces allowed experimentation with various crops and microclimates. We'll then stop for lunch before heading Ollantaytambo, a charming town known for impressive stone structures and remarkably preserved Inca urban layout. Our final stop is Pisac, renowned for its artisan market and its archaeological complex, where breathtaking views await before we return to your hotel in Cusco.
