


SOUTH VALLEY

Enjoy a lesser-traveled route that holds archaeological, colonial, and natural treasures. Live an experience that blends history, living culture, and unforgettable Andean landscapes.

ITINERARY

Our adventure to the South Valley of Cusco begins with pickup from your hotel to start a journey along one of the valley's most authentic and peaceful routes. The first stop will be Tipón, an impressive Inca archaeological complex known for its agricultural terraces and its sophisticated water-channel system that still functions today, a true masterpiece of hydraulic engineering. We will continue to Pikillaqta, a pre-Inca city belonging to the Wari culture, where you can admire its urban planning and the remains of ancient constructions surrounded by beautiful landscapes. Then we will visit Andahuayllas, a charming colonial town that is home to the Church of San Pedro Apóstol, known as the 'Sistine Chapel of the Americas' for its rich murals, carvings, and gold-leaf decorations. Finally, we will return to your hotel in Cusco after enjoying an enriching experience filled with history, art, and the living traditions of the southern Andes.



WHAT TO BRING?

- Stay hydrated and choose light snacks to enjoy the tour without discomfort.



- Wear comfortable shoes or trekking footwear, as you will be walking on uneven trails.



- Use sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat, as the sun in this area of Cusco is very strong.

- Bring your ID and cash in soles for snacks, souvenirs, and other expenses, as not everyone accepts cards.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Acclimate in Cusco at least one day before the tour to avoid altitude sickness.
- Have a light breakfast, as the tour includes several stops and transfers.
- Listen to the guide's explanations, as they will help you better understand the history and culture of the sites visited.
- Respect the rules of each place you visit.
- Support local artisans by purchasing authentic products in Andahuayllas.
- Maintain an environmentally responsible attitude, do not litter, and avoid touching ancient structures.
- Stay well hydrated during the tour and avoid excessive sun exposure.
- Be punctual and respect the schedule of each visit, as multiple stops will be made.
- Enjoy every moment, as the South Valley combines history, landscapes, and local life in a unique experience.
