Over two days, you will experience the complete Machu Picchu adventure. You will explore the legendary Inca citadel and, on the second day, conquer the summit of Huayna Picchu, enjoying unique views over the ruins and the Andean landscape.

ITINERARY

DAY 1: CUSCO – MACHU PICCHU - AGUAS CALIENTES

This adventure begins with pickup from your hotel in Cusco, Urubamba, or Ollantaytambo, followed by a transfer to the Ollantaytambo train station. From there, you will travel by train to Aguas Calientes, the town of Machu Picchu (approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes). Along the way, you can relax and enjoy views of rivers, mountains, agricultural terraces, and picturesque Andean communities.

Upon arrival in Aguas Calientes, your guide will be waiting to escort you to your hotel, provide all the necessary information, and then continue to the Aguas Calientes bus station. A 25-minute bus ride will take you to the main entrance of the Machu Picchu citadel. There, you will begin a guided tour lasting approximately 2 hours and 30 minutes, during which you will discover the history, architecture, and deep spirituality of the Inca citadel.

After the tour, you will have free time to explore at your own pace before returning to your hotel in Aguas Calientes, where you can enjoy lunch and rest.

ITINERARY

DAY 2: AGUAS CALIENTES - HUAYNA PICCHU - CUSCO

On this second day at the Machu Picchu citadel, your day begins with pickup from your hotel in Aguas Calientes. Your guide will meet you and accompany you to the bus station, from where you will ascend to the entrance gate of Machu Picchu. There, you will start a guided tour of approximately 2 hours and 30 minutes, during which you will explore one of the most exclusive and iconic areas of the sanctuary. From this privileged viewpoint, you will enjoy breathtaking panoramic views of the entire citadel while learning in depth about the history, architecture, and some of Machu Picchu's best-kept mysteries.

After the guided visit, you will have free time to explore the site at your own pace before returning to Aguas Calientes, where you can have lunch on your own. According to your train schedule, you will head to the train station to return to Ollantaytambo, where we will be waiting to transfer you back to your hotel in Cusco, bringing this wonderful experience to an end.



WHAT TO BRING?



- Wear comfortable, layered clothing to easily adapt to changing weather, as conditions in Cusco and Machu Picchu are different and can change suddenly.



- Wear shoes with good grip or comfortable trekking shoes, as you will walk along uneven trails.



- Use sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat, as the sun in Machu Picchu and throughout the entire route is very intense.



- Stay hydrated and choose light snacks to enjoy the tour comfortably and avoid discomfort.



- Bring your ID and some cash in Peruvian soles for snacks, souvenirs, etc., as not everyone accepts credit cards.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Be punctual at all times, as both train tickets and Machu Picchu entrance tickets have fixed schedules with no option for rescheduling.
- Stay hydrated by drinking water frequently.
- Avoid heavy or greasy meals before and during the tour.
- Take care of your belongings in markets and crowded areas.
- Get a good night's rest the night before, as the tour starts very early and ends on the second day in the evening, depending on train and entrance ticket schedules.
- Take time to calmly enjoy the views from the viewpoints and take photos, but also spend a few moments simply enjoying the place without a camera.
- Weather in Machu Picchu is unpredictable; you may experience strong sun, light rain, or mist on the same day.
- Stay calm and enjoy it, as each environment is part of the experience.
- Do not touch or climb on the structures, do not leave trash, and follow conservation rules; this ensures the experience remains unique for everyone.
- Remember that the tour involves waiting times for trains, buses, and entrances, but everything is worth it once you reach this Wonder of the World.
