# MARAS - MORAY & CHINCHERO

Explore these three jewels of the Sacred Valley that reveal Inca wisdom and Andean beauty. A journey that blends history, tradition, and breathtaking landscapes.

## ITINERARIO

Our journey begins with pick-up from your hotel in Cusco as we head toward the Sacred Valley. The first stop will be the Maras salt mines, where you'll marvel at this astonishing site made up of thousands of white salt pools that local families have used since Inca times. We then visit Moray, a truly unique archaeological site with circular terraces that the Incas used as an agricultural laboratory, experimenting with different microclimates to improve their crops, showcasing their impressive ingenuity and knowledge.

We continue to Chinchero, a charming Andean village known for its handmade textiles crafted with alpaca wool and natural dyes. Here, you'll witness a traditional weaving demonstration and visit its colonial church, built on Inca foundations and decorated with beautiful murals.

We finish the experience by returning to Cusco, enriched with history, living culture, and the breathtaking landscapes of the Sacred Valley.





## WHAT TO BRING?

- Stay hydrated and choose light snacks so you can enjoy the tour without discomfort.



- Wear comfortable or trekking shoes, as you will be walking on uneven paths.



- Bring your ID and cash for snacks, souvenirs, and other expenses, as not all places accept cards.



- Use sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat, as the sun in this area of Cusco is very strong.

## RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Avoid feeding or getting too close to local animals that roam freely.
- Respect all archaeological sites; avoid climbing structures or touching ancient elements.
- Support local artisans; Chinchero is famous for its handmade textiles.
- Carry cash, as small towns do not always accept card payments.
- Take care of the environment; do not leave trash and use reusable bottles.
- Follow your guide's instructions so you can fully enjoy this experience.
